## DEBT COLLECTION FEE AGREEMENT

This will confirm the agreement between \_\_\_\_\_,  
(the Client) and Richard R. Hubbard, (the Attorney) and sets forth the terms on  
which the Attorney agrees to represent the above referenced client.

For all undisputed debt collection cases (except unpaid rent), which have not  
been previously placed for collection or filed in court:

**100% of the recovery for each individual file first reimburses the Client for any court costs or sheriff fees incurred and paid through the Attorney's office for that file. The Attorney receives no legal fee until the Client has recovered these costs. For all additional amounts recovered, the Client receives 55% and the Attorney receives 45% of the first \$499 collected. For any additional monies, the Client receives 66.66% and the Attorney receives 33.33%. A case is considered disputed only if it requires a trial before a judge or clerk magistrate.**

For disputed cases, collection of rent, cases previously filed in court or placed  
with a collection agency or other attorney:

100% of the recovery first goes to reimburse the Client for any court costs  
or sheriff fees incurred after the case is placed with the Attorney. The  
Attorney receives no legal fee until the Client has recovered these costs.  
Then for all amounts collected, the Client receives 50% and the Attorney  
receives 50%.

In the rare instance where a judgment is appealed or the Attorney represents the  
Client in a counterclaim, an additional hourly legal fee may be required if the  
Client requests the Attorney to proceed.

The Attorney has the right to receive, endorse, deposit and disburse all checks  
received in the collection process. From time to time the Attorney may associate  
with or obtain coverage assistance from another attorney on any given file. By  
acceptance of this agreement, the Client acknowledges that this may occur and  
gives permission for the Attorney, acting as agent for Client, to do so if the need  
arises.
